One grant was paid to the Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation to support scholarships at two-year colleges. One grant was paid to Children's Healthcare of Atlanta for support of a pediatric medical residency and fellowship program which trained 124 pediatric subspecialists in 2011.

4b (Code:) (Expenses \$ 2015506. including grants of \$ 2000000.) (Revenue \$) Grants for Religion. One grant was paid to the Protestant Episcopal Theological Seminary in Virginia for a portion of the costs associated with rebuilding an historic chapel that was destroyed by fire.

4c (Code:) (Expenses \$ 453489. including grants of \$ 450000.) (Revenue \$) Grants for Human Services. Two grants were paid to youth serving organizations, one of which went to Boys' Home in Virginia for renovation of two facilities. The second grant was paid to the State YMCA of Georgia for general operating support for its statewide youth leadership programs.
